Monitoring Well Construction Update – August 10, 2023 Wells are described below in the order in which they are drilled

Bahr Drive Monitoring Well (SMGWA-5)



- Drilling began on May 22
- Groundwater encountered at depth of 43 feet
- Total drilled depth of 70 feet
- Well construction completed on May 24

Geyer Quarry Monitoring Well (SMGWA-8)




- Drilling began on May 25
- Groundwater encountered at depth of 22 feet
- Total drilled depth of 200 feet
- Well construction completed on May 31

Ruins Creek (SMGWA-3)



- Drilling began on June 1
- Groundwater encountered at depth of 105 feet
- Total drilled depth of 175 feet
- Well construction completed on June 7

Love Creek Road (SMGWA-7)



- Drilling started June 22
- Temporary traffic light posted at both ends of the site during construction
- Total drilled depth of 185 feet
- Well construction completed on June 30

Quail Hollow (SMGWA-6)



- Drilling started July 10
- Groundwater encountered at depth of 75 feet
- Total drilled depth of 140 feet
- Well construction completed on July 14

Nelson Road (SMGWA-4)



- Drilling began on July 31
- Groundwater encountered at depth of 10 feet
- Total drilled depth of 85 feet
- Well construction completed on August 9

Bean Creek (SMGWA-2)



- Drilling began on August 10
- Planned drilling depth to 80 feet
